*Edited from secondary sources for the use of Vocalis, Frankfurt. The layout for double choir reflects the traditional (and current) seating arrangement of English Cathedral and Collegiate choirs. Verse and Full (Solo and Tutti) markings, here shown in the top part only, are taken as applying to all voices participating in a given section and, if they are to be observed, a minimum of twenty voices is required. Note values unchanged. Regular barring added. Transposed up a minor third. Organ part omitted (it doubles at the unison those voice parts playable by manuals only, invariably including the highest and lowest notes, and may have been for rehearsal only). Underlay chosen by the editor, mostly from amongst the MS sources, and slurs added. Composition is now thought to date from the 1580s.*
